

FINISH COLLECTION

Six finishes. One consistent architectural system.

Use this guide as a starting point, then confirm the final choice with a physical sample in the actual garden.

Dark Grey

A neutral charcoal finish for contemporary gardens and modern homes.

01 Works well with pale porcelain, render and architectural planting.

02 Creates a restrained background that allows planting to lead.

Black

A deep statement finish for strong contrast and minimal design schemes.

01 Pairs with black-framed glazing, darker paving and dramatic planting.

02 Use physical samples to assess detail in shaded areas.

Light Grey

A pale cool neutral that keeps the boundary visually lighter.

01 Complements pale stone, porcelain and rendered properties.

02 Useful where a darker boundary may feel too dominant.

Teak

A muted timber-inspired tone that introduces warmth without annual staining.

01 Pairs naturally with oak tones, warm paving and grasses.

02 Assess in daylight because warm finishes vary most between screens.

Chestnut

A deeper brown suited to brickwork and established gardens.

01 Works with warmer masonry and mature planting.

02 Provides a more traditional material character within a contemporary system.

Ancient Wood

A smoky greige with a softer, weathered visual character.

01 Pairs with stone, gravel and muted landscape palettes.

02 A useful bridge between grey and timber-inspired finishes.
