

PROJECT PLANNING

Plan the boundary before you price the detail.

Accurate project information helps produce a clearer quotation and reduces avoidable changes later.

Information to gather

Before requesting a formal quotation, collect the following where possible.

- 01 Overall fence length measured along the intended boundary line.
- 02 Required height and any changes in level along the run.
- 03 Number and approximate location of corners, ends and gates.
- 04 Photographs of the boundary, ground conditions and access route.
- 05 Any drawings, planning information or known constraints.

Site and installation considerations

The fencing system is only one part of a successful installation.

- 01 Ground conditions and substrate suitability should be assessed before fixing.
- 02 Existing walls, slabs, retaining structures or drainage may affect the installation approach.
- 03 Access for materials and safe installation should be considered early.
- 04 Final fixing and structural requirements should be determined for the actual site conditions.

Before ordering

Use the planning stage to confirm the specification.

- 01 Choose the system and finish.
- 02 Confirm dimensions after any paving or finished levels that affect height.
- 03 Review gate requirements and opening direction.
- 04 Confirm delivery access and storage arrangements.

Important

This guide is intended to support early-stage planning. Site conditions, structural requirements, fixing methods, dimensions and installation details should be verified for the individual project before ordering or installation.
